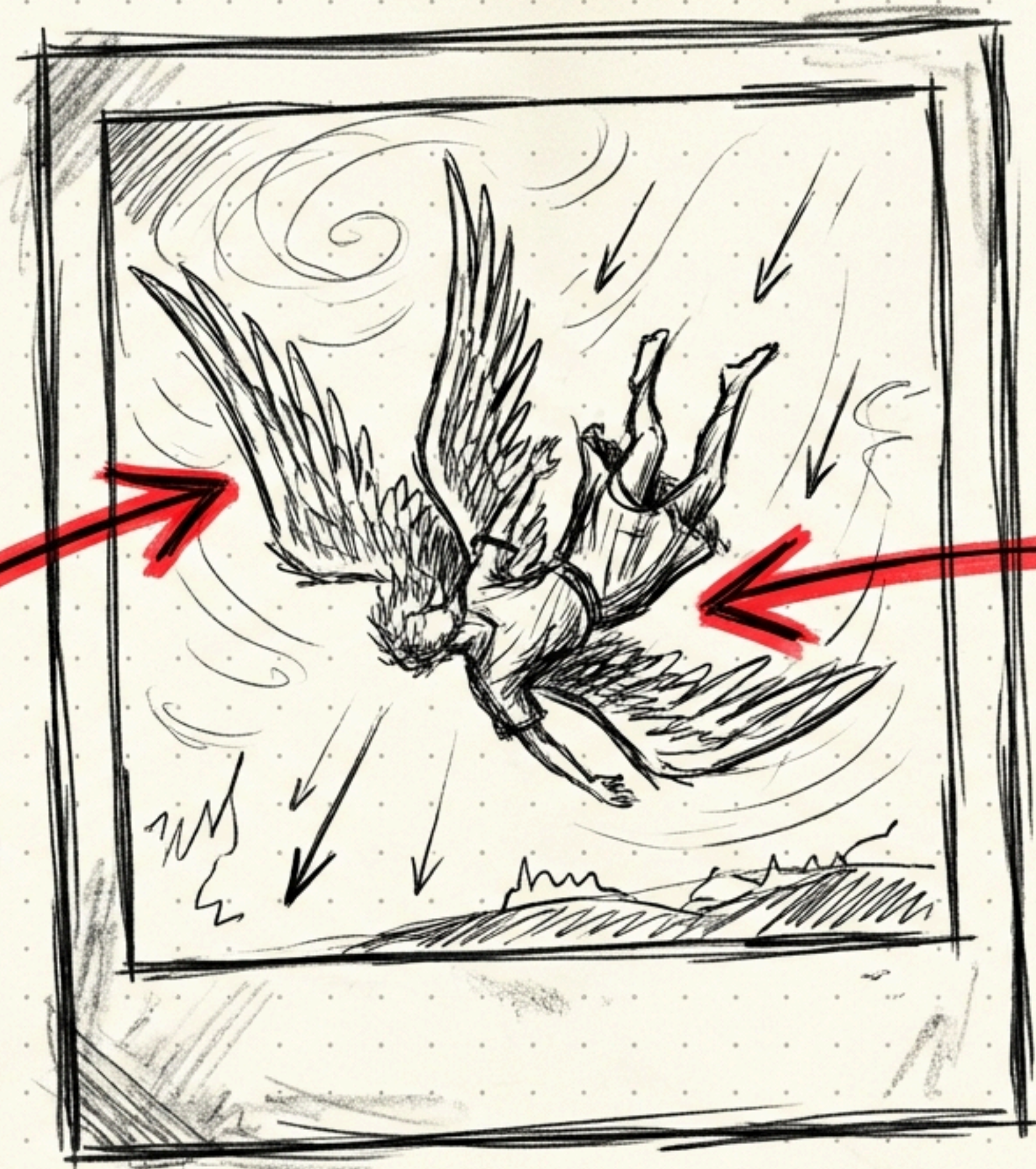

# The Target Audience of Grace



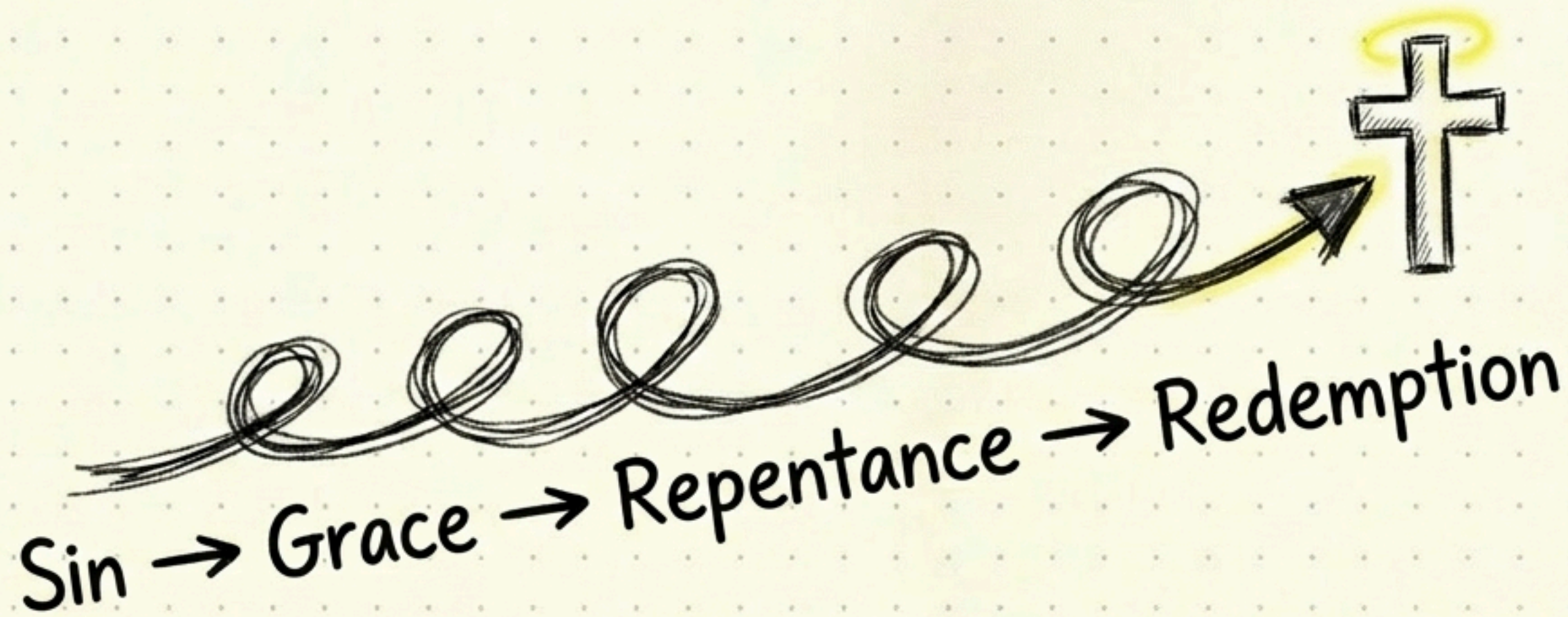
Salvation is for humans, not angels. Jesus took on human form, not angelic form, to redeem mankind.

# The Design Difference

	Human	Satan
Form	Physical Body & Soul	 Spirit Being/ Guardian Cherub (Ezekiel 28:14)
Image	 Made in God's Image (Genesis 1:27)	Not made in God's image.

Satan isn't just a bad person. He is an entirely different category of creation.

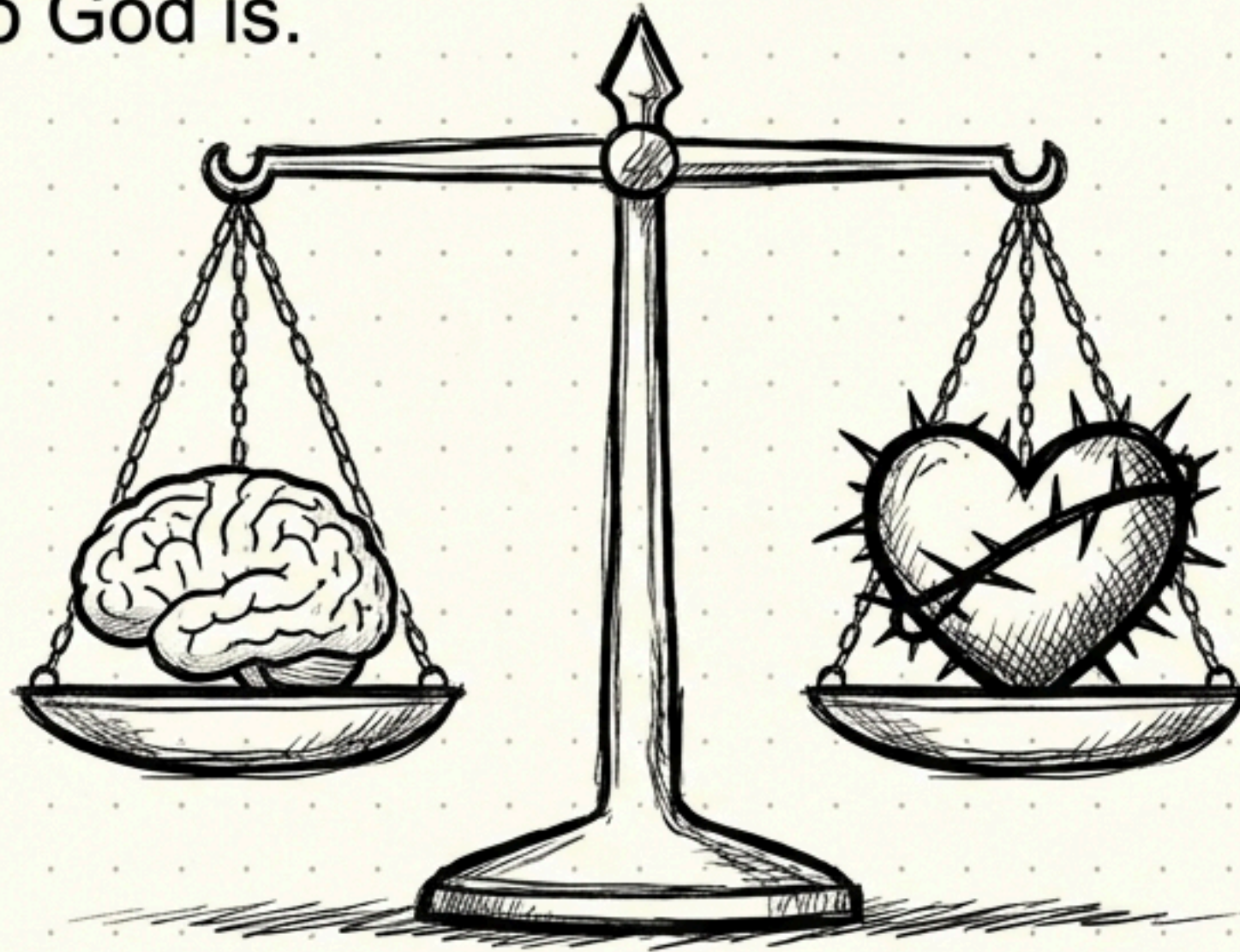


Angelic decision = Final.

He knows exactly who God is.

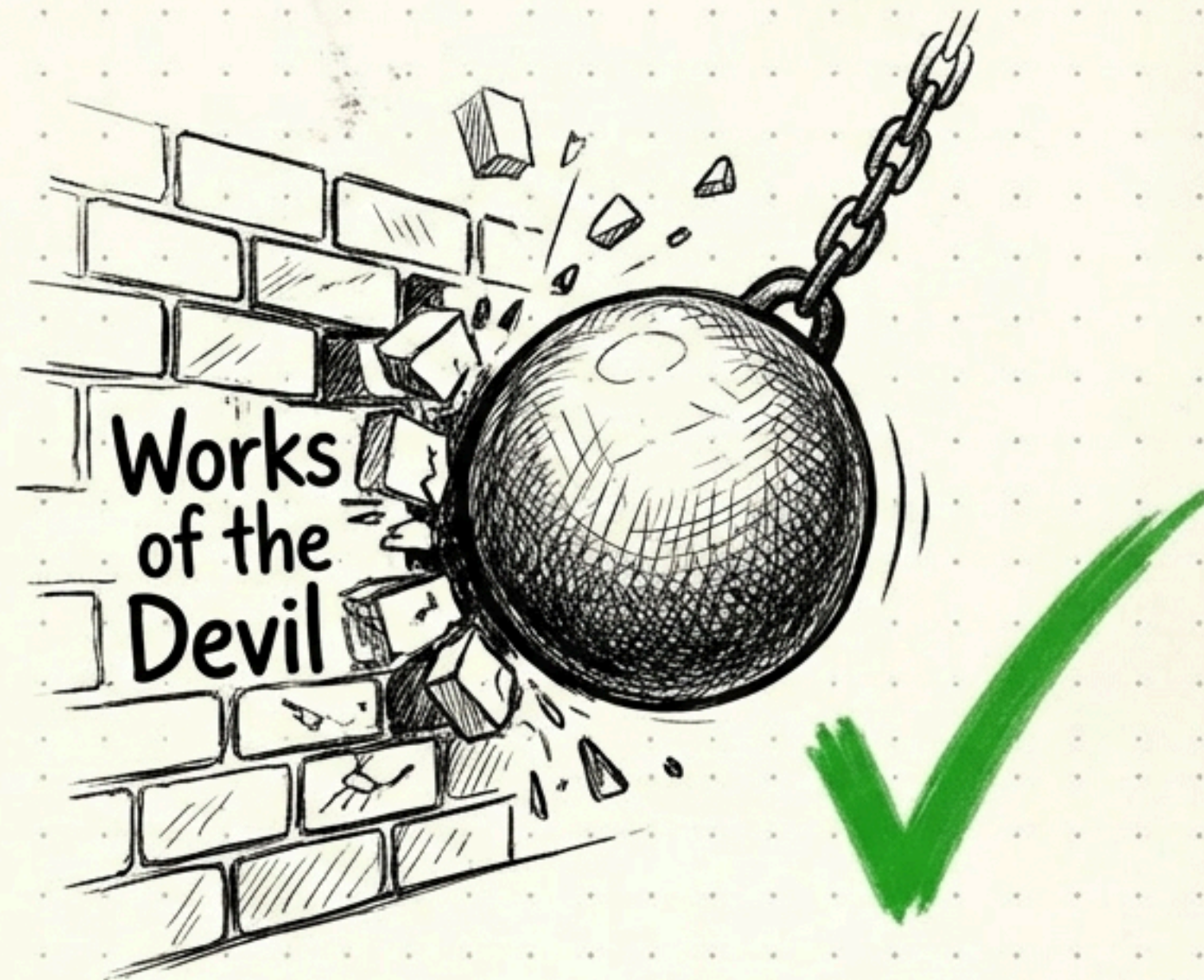


Even demons believe

Total Knowledge + Ultimate Rebellion = Unredeemable



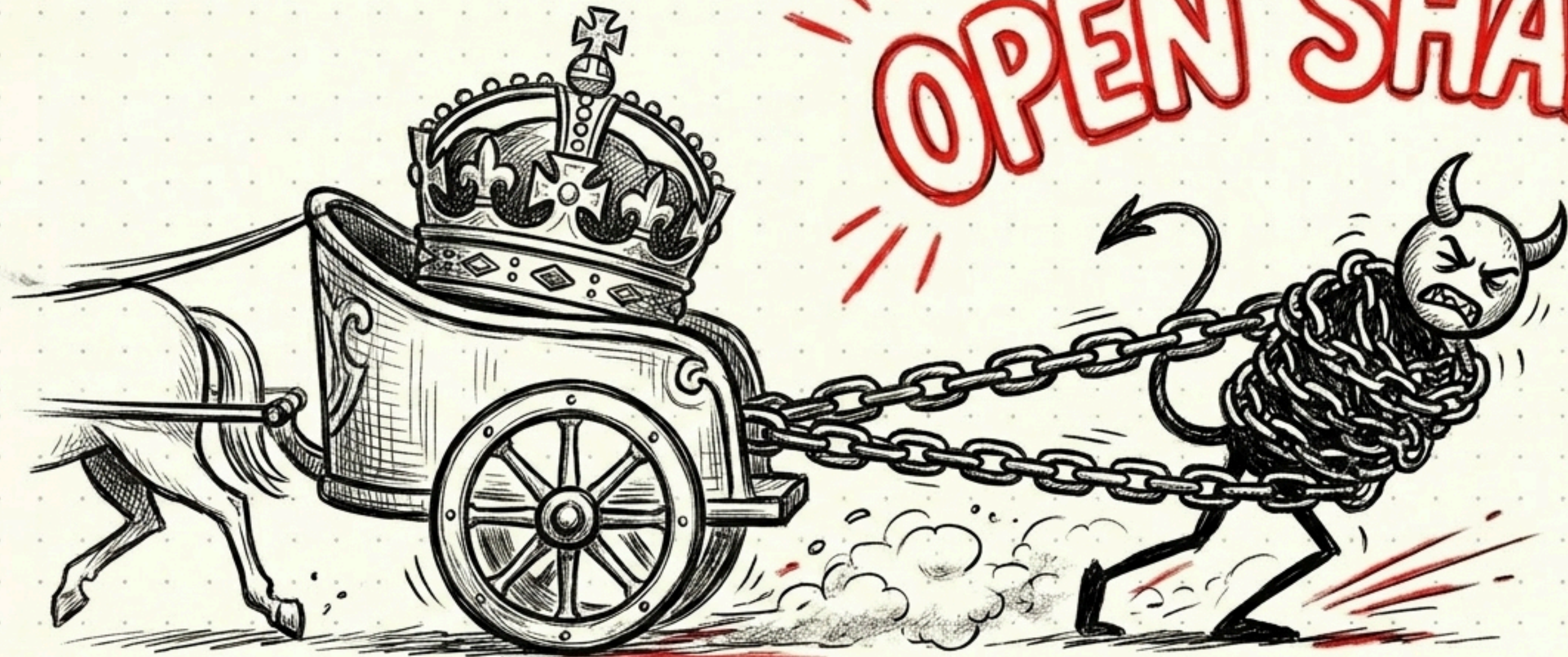
The Cross is a lifeline

# The Victory Parade

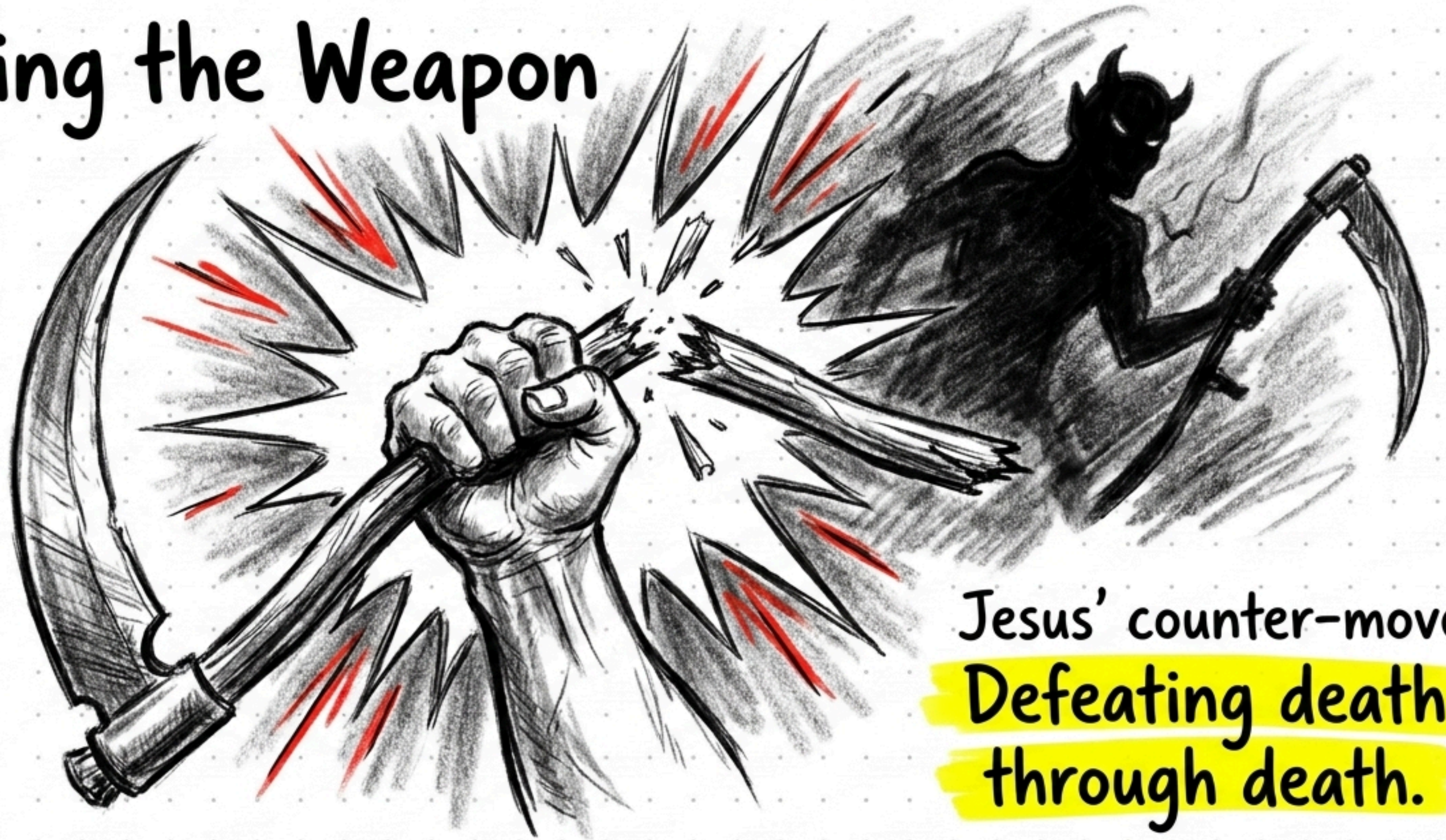


○ Disarmament & Shame. Jesus didn't just defeat Satan; He embarrassed him.

Hebrews 2:14 (He shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil)

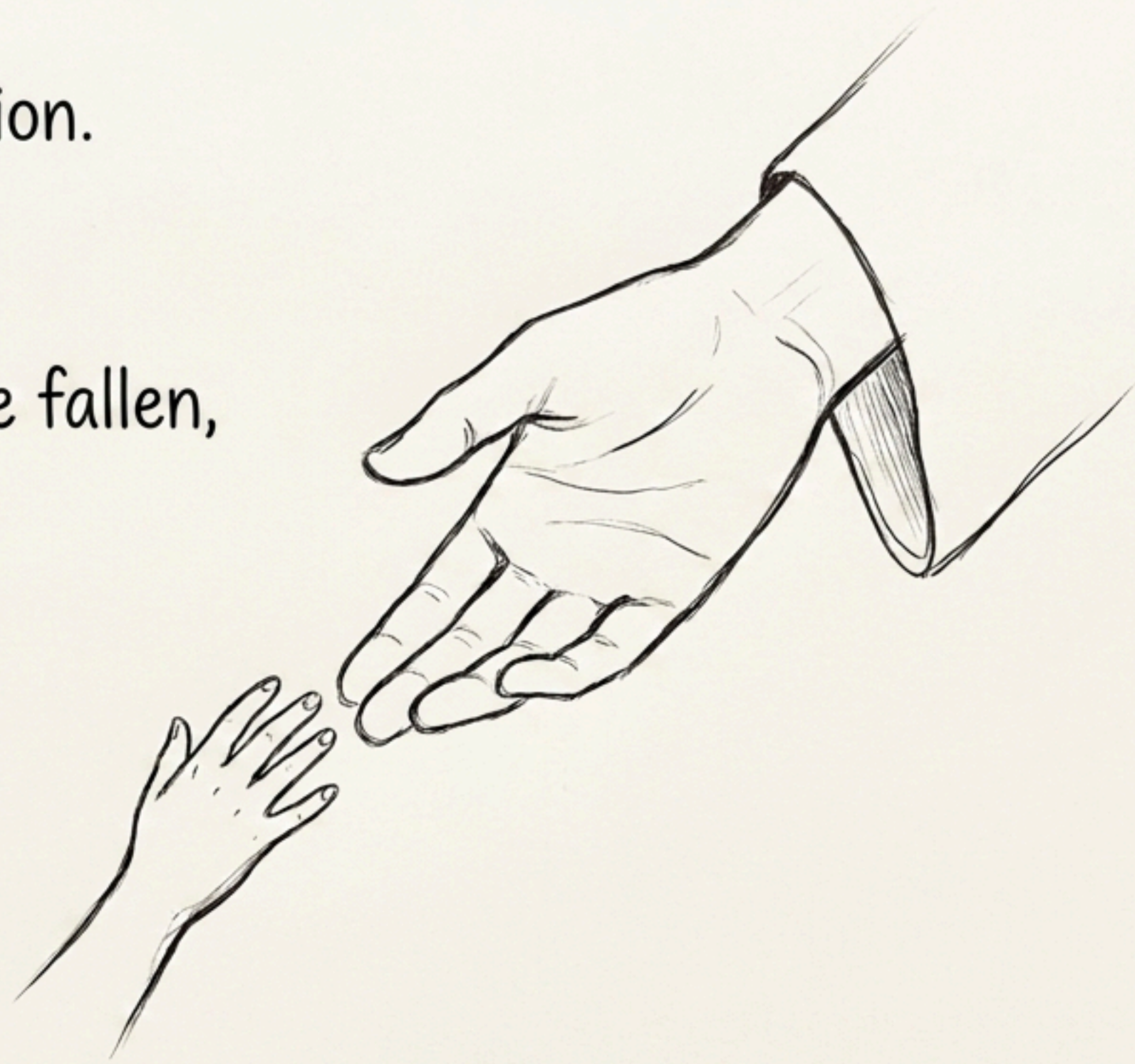
