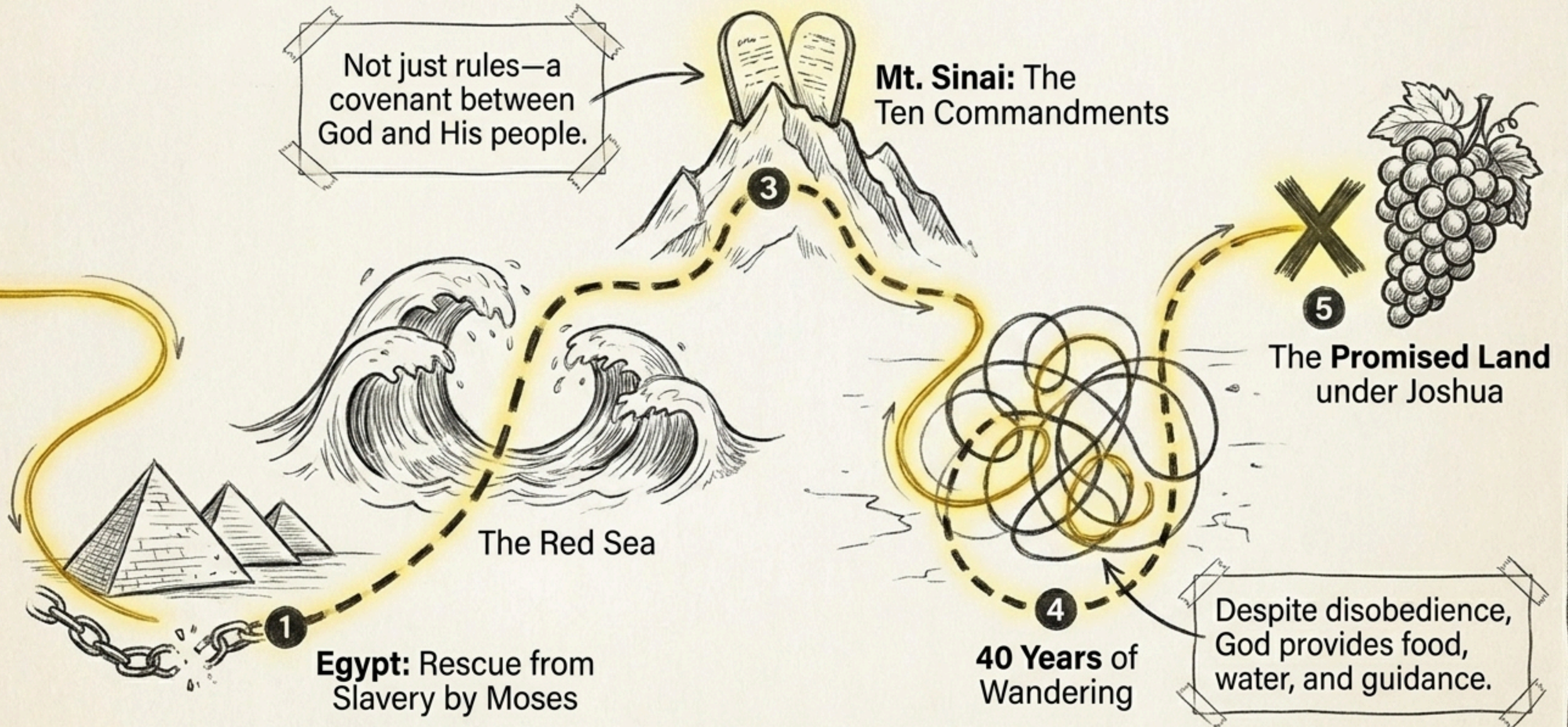

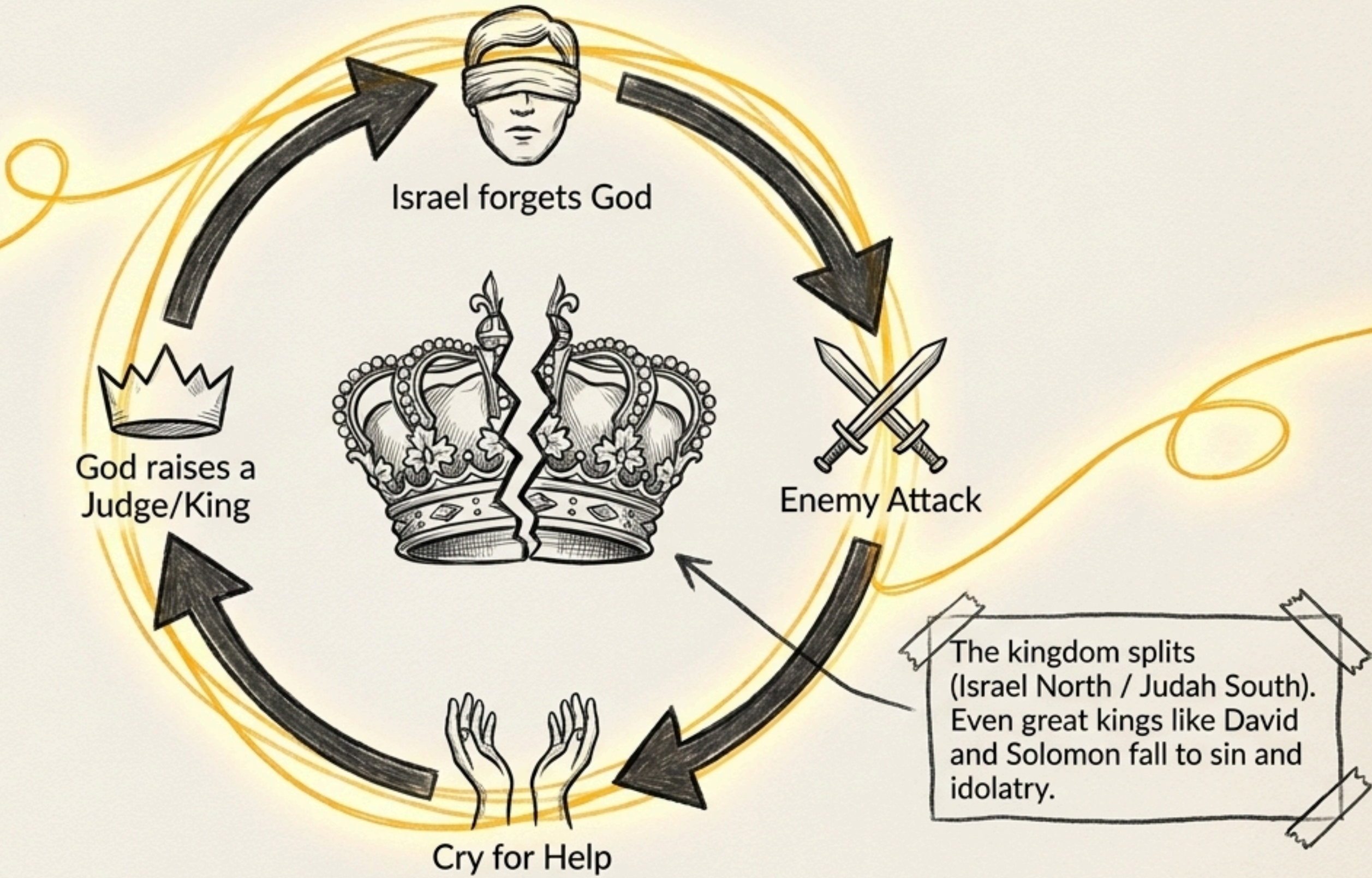



remains intact.*

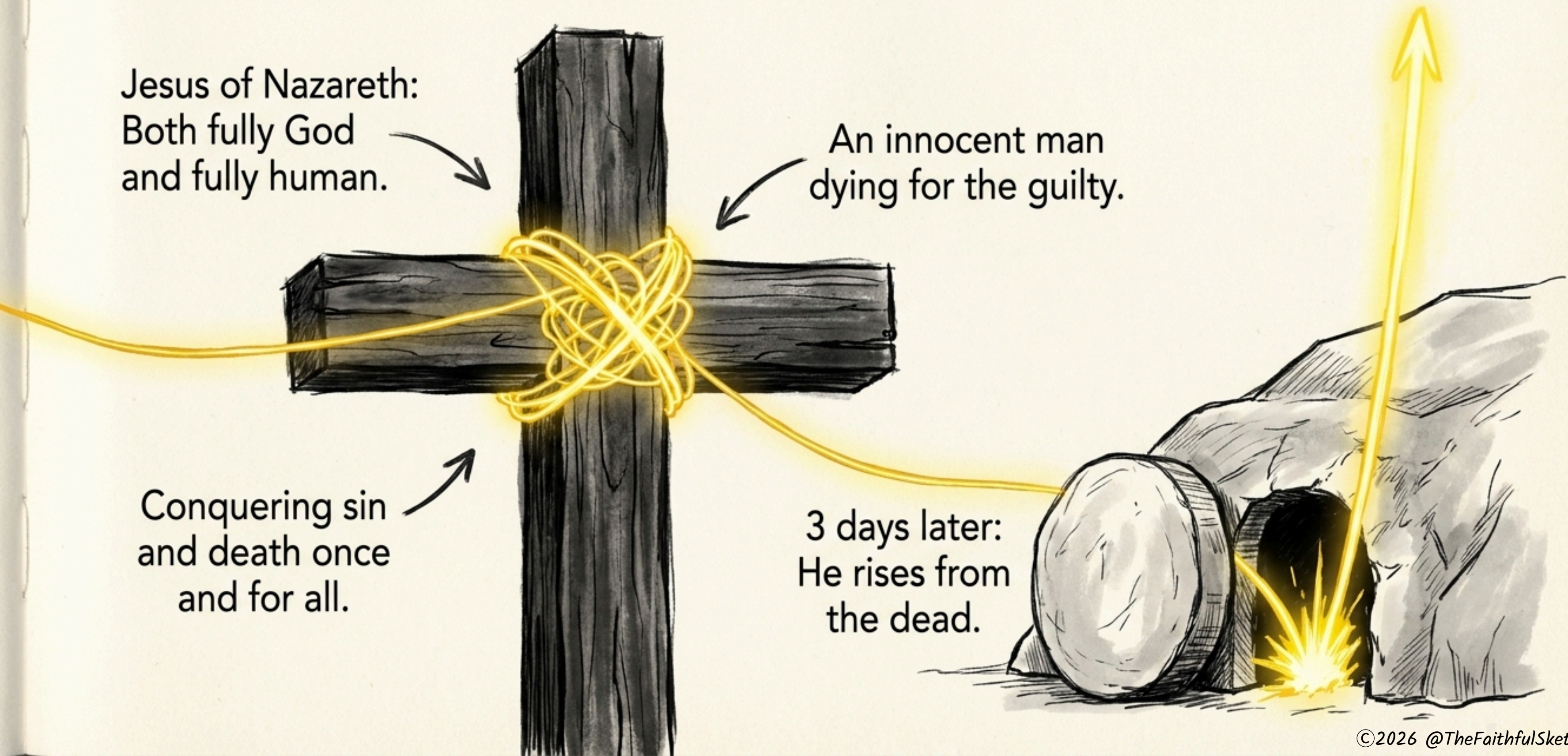
Jesus steps into history as the center of the story.

GENESIS (The Fracture)

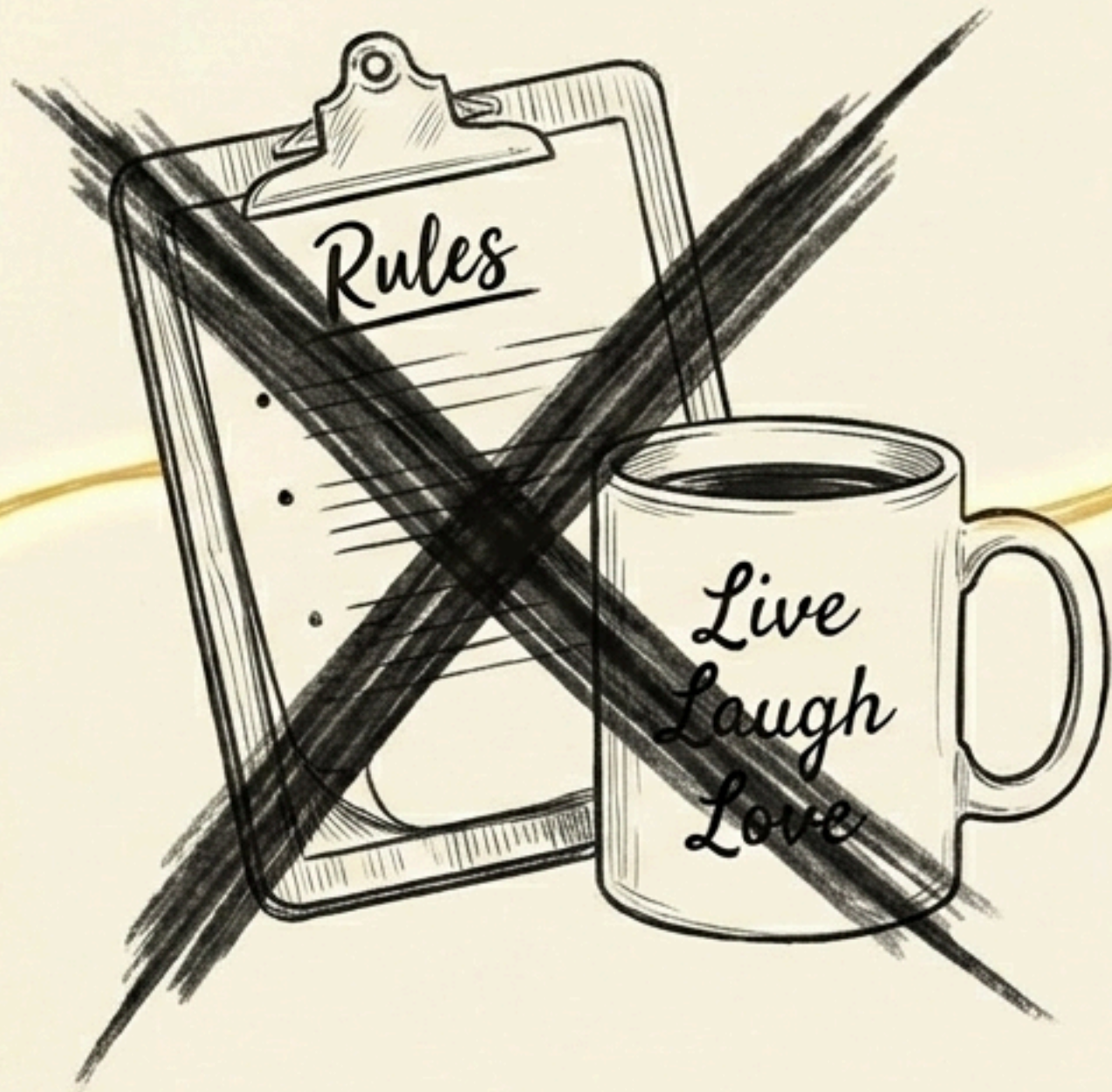

REVELATION (The Restoration)

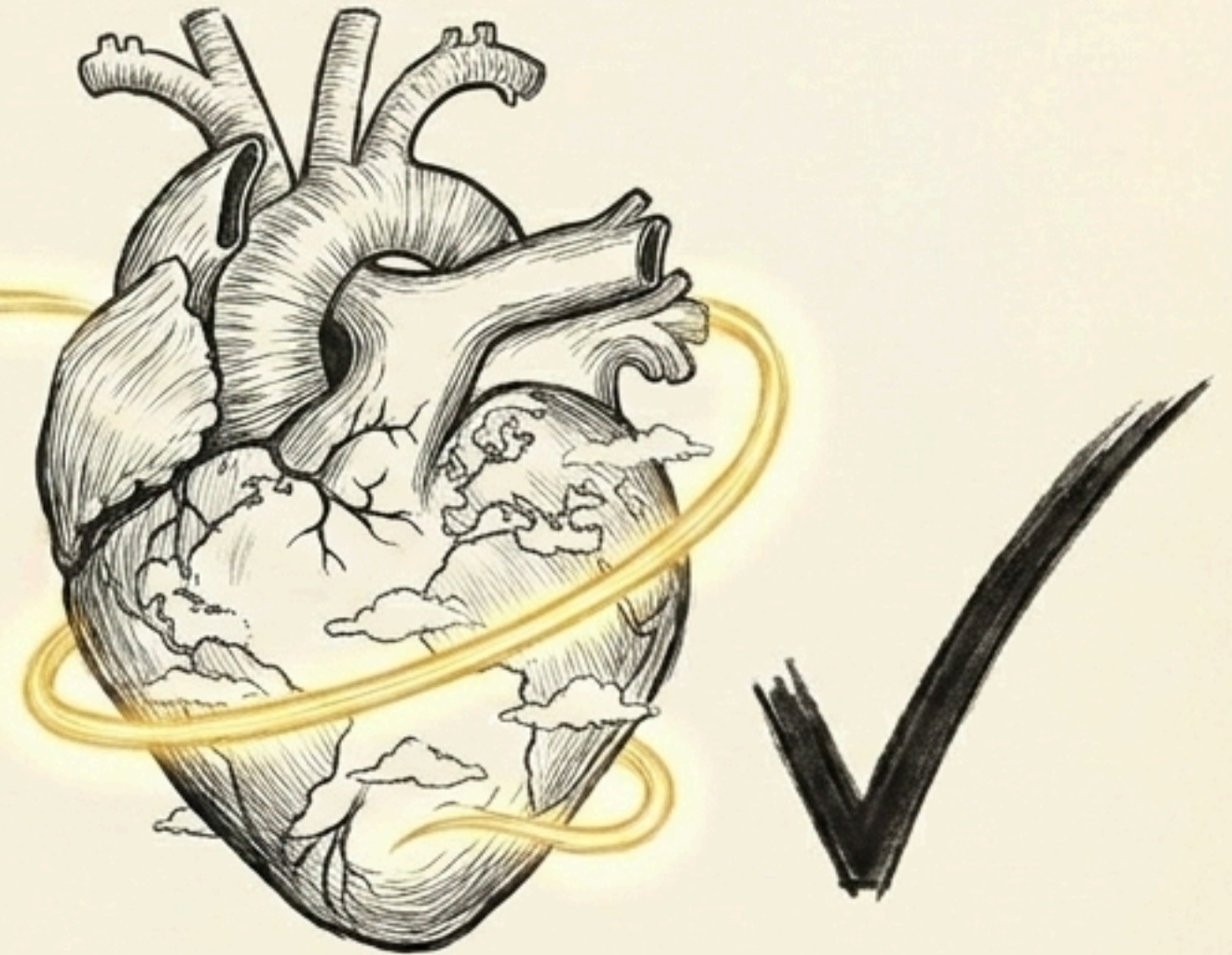
- New heavens & new earth

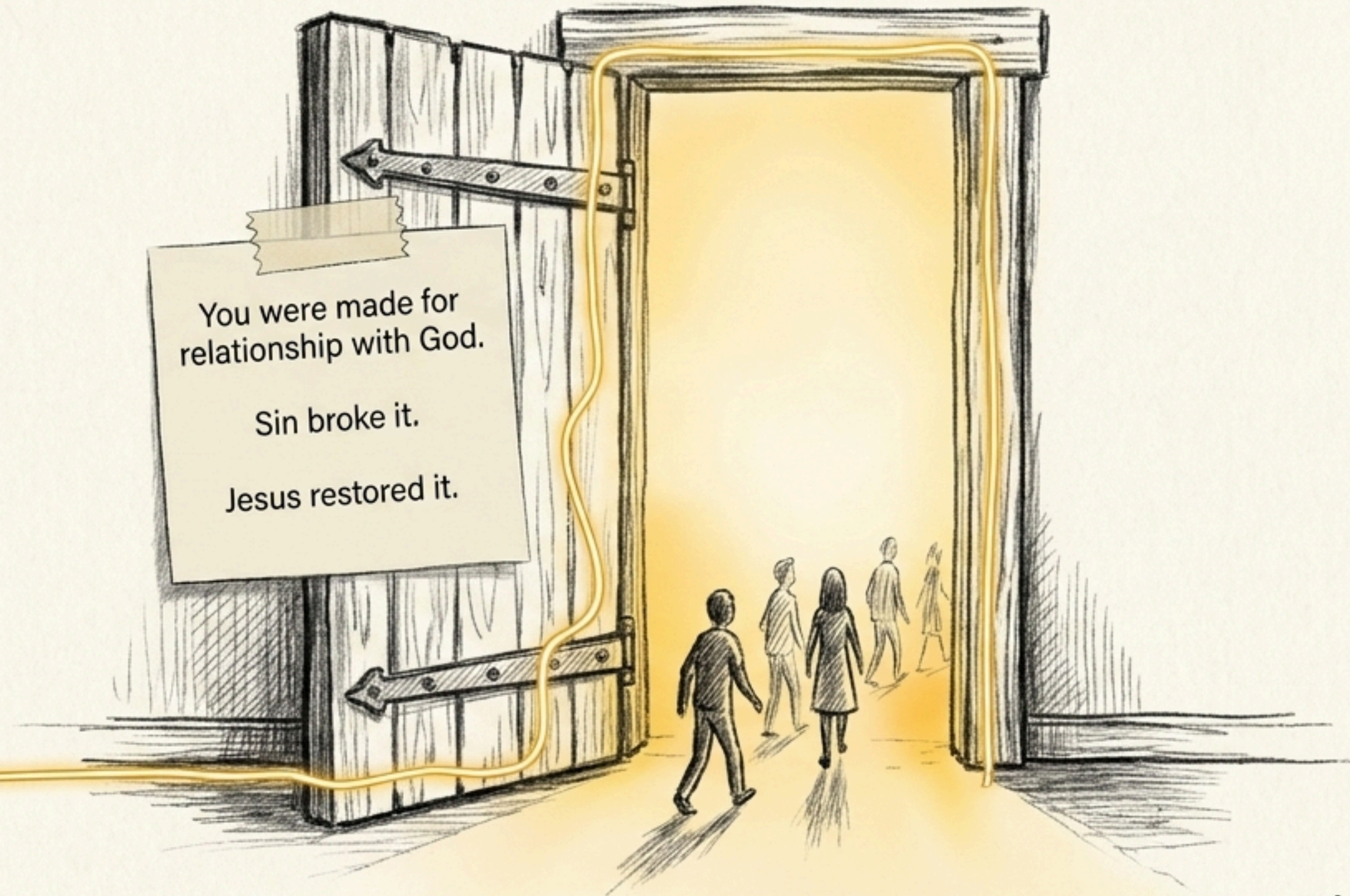
